

Altus Flutes Artist Christopher Lee is a laureate of the AGIMUS International Competition in Italy and grant recipient of the Canada Council for the Arts. From 1991 to 2013 he was Principal Flute of the Toronto Philharmonia.

Chris performs and gives masterclasses internationally with engagements in England, Italy, Spain, Belgium, the USA, Costa Rica, Panama, Peru, Honduras, and Brazil. In addition there have been performances at the conventions of the British Flute Society, the National Flute Association (USA), and the Canadian Flute Association.

Chris has recorded two solo discs and appeared on several others as guest.

Chris plays on the Altus flute and Miguel Arista headjoint.
